A service auditor's examination performed in accordance with SAS No. 70 ("SAS 70 Audit") is widely recognized, because it represents that a service organization has been through an in-depth audit of their control objectives and control activities.

These often include controls over information technology and related processes. In today's global economy, service organizations or service providers must demonstrate that they have adequate controls and safeguards when they host or process data belonging to their customers.

The contract calls for the preliminary review to be completed by April of this year. Type II certification will be completed by no later than September of 2009. The contract also requires annual review for recertification over the next 4 years.
